The Rules

- NO Visitors will be allowed at Band Camp. Parents are the ONLY Exception to this Rule, your boyfriend/girlfriend will be sent home!
- Medications must be checked in with the nurse prior to departure for camp, no exceptions! This is a School, County, and State policy.
- Absolutely NO: alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, non-prescription drugs, controlled substances, or drug-related paraphernalia.
- EVERYON EATS! Do not choose this week to begin your diet, you need to eat properly in order to maintain your energy.
- NO Profanity
- No disturbing other camper's property!
- No leaving campus (camp) for any reason.
- Girls are NOT permitted on the Boy's floor, Boys are NOT permitted on the Girl's floor!
- There will be NO Hazing Activities! No freshman initiating will occur! We believe in an inviting, wholesome atmosphere. We want all band members to feel welcome and look forward to their return back to the organization!

What You Should Bring To Camp:

- Personal Bedding (sleeping bag, pillow)
- Plenty of comfortable marching clothes (school appropriate) and shoes.
- TENNIS SHOES and plenty of socks!
- Suntan lotion, hat, visor and sunglasses.
- All necessary practice equipment (instrument, silks, reeds, sticks, valve oil, music, and at least 2 pencils).
- Towels and Wash Cloths
- Toiletry Articles (soap, shampoo, etc..)
- Medicated powder – for chafing.
- Bathing suit – for swimming only, not to be worn during practice times
- Bug Spray
- Ace bandages or braces for weak ankles or such
- Money for anything you may need from the Bandland Rep (reeds, oil, lyres, flip folders). We will provide a form prior to camp so that your parents know the cost.
- Game Room: Fairmont State College allows us the use of their game room during break times, these games do require money to play if you are interested in using them.

What NOT TO BRING To Camp:

- Valuables
- Large Amounts of Cash
- Jewelry
- Stereo Systems
- Guns, Knives, Bombs or other Terrorist Items.
- Drugs, Alcohol and Etc..
- If you are caught breaking the above rules, you will be sent home at your parent's expense. The authorities will be called if you are caught with weapons, drugs, etc..

OTHER:

Band Camp Forms will be provided to the students prior to camp each year. These packets will provide details regarding the cost of camp, the supplies you need, the dates of camp and any other necessary information.

Band Directors will provide a tentative daily schedule before the beginning of camp each year and will also provide a donation request list for snacks/supplies/etc... that may be needed for our students.
